

DIY Watermelon Gift Tags

Materials:

Pencil
Glue
Tags
Thread (green)
Needle
Watercolors
Paint brush
Scissors
Circle punch

Directions:

- 1) Use circle punch to cut out circle
- 2) Fold the piece of paper around tag to create a crease in the middle of the circle
- 3) Use watercolors to paint the middle of the circle like a watermelon slice. Leave white space along the edge of the circle.
- 4) Place the circle on the tag, make sure to align the crease with the edge of the tag.
- 5) Paint a thin green line on the tag around the white space.
- 6) Punch holes in the tag between the white outline and the inside of the green outline.
- 7) Add stitching along the inside of the green outline, knot and tie off on the back of the tag.

- 8) Punch holes in the tag on the outside of the green outline.
- 9) Add stitching along the outside of the green outline, knot and tie off on the back of the tag.
- 10) Glue down the piece of paper to the tag
- 11) Use watercolors to paint the watermelon seeds
- 12) Once dry, write a personalized message on the back of the tag.
